To inform you as to

Sir: In regards to my son Thomas Henley and he was the undersigned assistant at the times of the unlawful arrest and procedure of 2/5 – 2/6 – 2/7. I refer to you to my letter addressed county Com. of Law Co. 4-12-22. The warrant continued no probable cause of action and was not read to my said son.

Prof. Hoffmaster jerked a picture off the wall in the front room of my house and handed to one of the state police and said “there I have been in this home (my father’s) many a times,” why did he do it? Please find enclosed a copy of articles IV and a an abstract of Articles V. of the U.S. Constitution and also refer you to section 2, Article 6, No. 2, Article 3, Section 2, No. 2, of the U.S. Constitution
