My son, Thomas was employed by Stone and Webster Engineering Corporation of Youngstown, Ohio, as a Sine Man on the Transmission Line from Lowellville, Ohio to Elwood City, Pa. and on May 5, 1916 about 10 AM my son was injured by a jin pole falling and hitting him across the back and he has been injured very bad and his sufferings have been very severe.

I ask you to make a thorough investigation of his injuries as he is justly entitled to a substantial compensation for the injury that he has sustained.
